BIOGRAPHICAL/HISTORICAL NOTE

Born December 6, 1905 in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. His father was a Hungarian emigrant and mother was from New Orleans, Louisiana. They owned Lustig's Bookstore in Tuscaloosa. Lustig studied chemical engineering at Bernard College in Cullman, Alabama and later moved to California, where he worked for North American Aviation, Inc, the Douglas Aircraft Company, and the Continental Aeronautic Corp. Catalytic Engineering and Manufacturing Corporation in Fort Valley, Georgia, where he invented many items. Lustig also wrote for the *Peach County Enterprise* mainly on political issues. He married Dorothea [?] and had a child, Leila [?]
