This is an excellent opportunity for students to meet Dr. Diouf and talk to her about her research and interests.

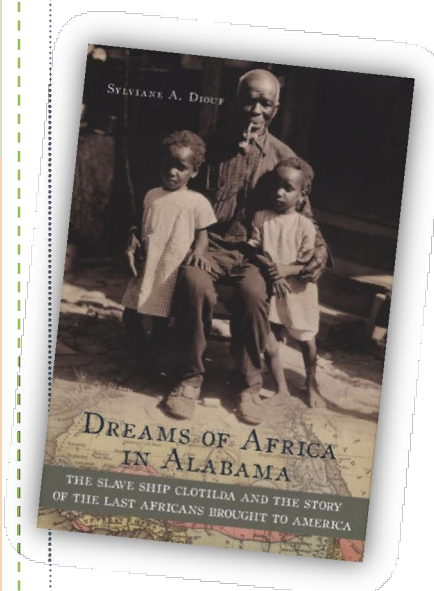
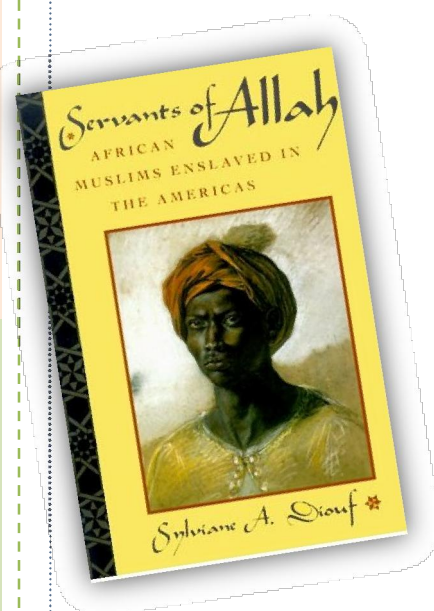
And Dr. Diouf will discuss and sign copies of her latest book,
